We would like to invite you to the annual Debbie Rendle Memorial Race, which will take place on Saturday 11th April 2015.

We will be starting the race as usual, from the tidal barrier at Truro and finishing at the Pandora Inn, Restronguet. Please note that the bottom of the slip is very muddy so launching may be awkward. As in previous years the race will be run on a handicap basis and in order to beat the receding tide we need to hold the **Coxes Meeting at 0900 for a 1030 start.**

We have obtained permission from the relevant bodies for parking at the car park adjacent to the start. Please make sure you leave your trailers out of the way of others parking there. Parking for boat trailers has also been arranged at Restronguet on the adjacent pier.

Please bring with you on the day an entry fee of £2.00per rower and the completed entry form which is attached, and hand this to Sean Boyle before the Coxes Meeting. If you wish and are able, send 'digitally' to sean@atngroup.uk The rules are also included with this letter.

PLEASE COMPLETE ONE ENTRY FORM PER BOAT ENTERED

THE DEBBIE RENDLE MEMORIAL RACE 11th April 2015

- 1 All boats will be raced on a handicap basis.
- 2 Entry forms with the registration fee of £2 per rower should be handed to Kath Statham **before the cox meeting**.
- 3 All boats must carry a pump plus 1 bailer, alternatively 2 bailers.
- 4 All flash boat coxswains and all under 18 rowers to wear lifejackets.
- 5 Mixed crews preferable, but at least **one adult** minimum per boat (no exceptions).
- 6 Remember to follow the channel marker buoys i.e. red can buoys to the right, green cone buoys to the left.
- 7 Priority to be given to large vessels in the channel.
- 8 Priority to be given to displacement sailing yachts in the channel.
- 9 It is the responsibility of the adult in the crew to direct their boat behind the King Harry Ferry.

HANDICAPS: Start and finish times will be recorded. Handicaps will then be deducted from elapsed time. Slower boat categories will start first.
