2015 Tribute Series

The Tribute Series will revert back to the format of 2013 – all events count with the exception of limited numbers or invite only events.

It is requested that each host club send their results in to racing.cpga@gmail.com as soon as possible after their event within 7 days after the event.

Points will be allocated based on the number of entries to each race at that event. The winner will get maximum points, last place in the race will get 1 point, DQs and clubs not participating will get 0 points.

Example.

Race A has 7 participants. The winner will get 7points, 2nd place 6points 3rd place 5points and so on

Race B has 15 participants. The winner will get 15points, 2nd will get 14points, 3rd will get 13points and so on.

The crew with the most points at the end of the season in each category will be Tribute Champions. The club with the highest combined total of Men's A, Men's B, U16, Ladies A and Ladies B points will be the Overall Champions

Unlike previous seasons, all B crews will be assumed composite, please mark genuine crews with a '*' when submitting results. It will be the responsibility of the crew to inform the host club that they are genuine. 0 points will be awarded to composite crews, but there is no ban on them racing (unless the host club requires this)

Veteran races will not count towards the tribute series due to no standard format (could have separate ladies and mens races or a combined race). Mixed races and U14 races will also not count towards the Tribute Series

Every club must submit their list of registered racing members to the CPGA secretary along with a copy of their insurance policies by the specified date

Once the points are tallied up, an end of season party and presentation at St Austell Brewery will held mid October where all clubs are invited to attend
