RACE ORDER

Coxswains Meeting 9:30am, upstairs in the rowing club.

First Race 10am

Rounds 1 – Semi Finals will be a shortened triangular course
Plate Final and Final will be the full Newquay Course

1. **Round 1 (23 crews): 4 Heats of 6 or 5 Crews.**
1st and 2nd places plus 10 fastest losers go through to QF, rest (6 crews) to Plate SF.
2. **Quarter Finals (18 Crews): 3 Heats of 6.**
1st and 2nd place plus 6 fastest losers go through to SF, rest (6 crews) to Plate SF

Break

3. **Plate Semi Finals (12 Crews): 2 Heats of 6.**
1st place plus 4 fastest losers go through to Plate Final
4. **Semi Finals (12 Crews): 2 Heats of 6.**
1st place plus 4 fastest losers go through to Final

Break

5. **Plate Final (6 crews): 1 Heat of 6**
6. **Final (6 crews): 1 Heat of 6**

Presentations outside the rowing club shortly after the finals.

Final Details/Reminders

Under 16 Championship Sunday 26th July 2015

- Clubs are required to **provide your own oars, spare pins and a working VHF Radio.**
- **Clubs loaning a gig are asked to provide a set of seats and pins for each gig**, to speed up changeovers on the beach, can clubs **please bring spare pins to replace any that they break** in the races.
- **All rowers and coxswains must wear lifejackets** (provided by your own club).
- Your **Public Liability Insurance** should be registered with the CPGA secretary prior to the event, as should all rowers participating in the event.

There will be prizes for; Junior Under 16 Champions, all main finalists, highest placed Mixed Crew, highest placed All-Girl Crew and the Plate Race Champions. Presentations will take place shortly after the final.

Previous winners please return cup/shield presented last year, prior to the event, thank you.

Umpires Meeting will be at **9:15am**. Please see separate rota for umpiring attached, clubs are reminded that they need to provide one representative (or more if willing) to umpire their allotted races. The **coxswains meeting** will be at **9:30am**, upstairs in the Rowing Club and a register of clubs attending will be taken. It is essential that at least one representative from your club (coxswains only) attends this meeting as it gives you important information about racing rules and safety. The gigs are loaned to us in good faith, so coxswains should have a good level of competence (no novice coxswains please).

Hot and cold food, pasties, burgers, sandwiches, cakes and hot and cold beverages will be available from the gig shed.

In the **event of cancellation** due to adverse weather conditions, please check the CPGA website on the Friday/Saturday beforehand. Individual e-mails will be sent to club secretaries of registered crews. We have **two reserve dates**, calendared in advance, should the event need to be postponed due to adverse weather conditions, the event will take place during the Sunday of the senior championships: a) **Sunday 6th September** (Ladies Championships) b) **Sunday 20th September** (Men's Championships).
