Mens County Championships and Reschedules Under-16 Championship Saturday 19th and Sunday 20th September 2015 Final Details including Race Order/Progression

- Clubs are required to **provide your own oars, spare pins and a working VHF Radio.**
- **Clubs loaning a gig are asked to provide a set of seats and pins for each gig**, to speed up changeovers on the beach, can clubs **please bring spare pins to replace any that they break** in the races.
- **All U16 rowers and coxswains must wear lifejackets** (provided by your own club), it is advised that all coxswains wear a lifejacket.
- Your **Public Liability Insurance** should be registered with the CPGA secretary prior to the event, as should all rowers participating in the event.

There will be prizes for; All Mens and U16 finalists and, as well as highest placed U16 Mixed Crew, highest placed U16 All-Girl Crew and the U16 Plate Race Champions. Presentations will take place shortly after the all the finals have concluded.

Previous winners please return cup/shield presented last year, prior to the event, thank you.

Umpires Meeting will be at **8:00am Saturday**. A separate rota for umpiring will be sent out before the event, clubs are reminded that they need to provide one representative (or more if willing) to umpire their allotted races. The **coxswains meeting** will be at **8:45am Saturday (MENS) and 9:00am Sunday (U16)**, upstairs in the Rowing Club and a register of clubs attending will be taken. It is essential that at least one representative from your club (coxswains only) attends this meeting as it gives you important information about racing rules and safety. The gigs are loaned to us in good faith, so coxswains should have a good level of competence (no novice coxswains please).

Hot and cold food, pasties, burgers, sandwiches, cakes and hot and cold beverages will be available from the gig shed, as well as 2015 County Gig Championship Clothing.

In the **event of cancellation** due to adverse weather conditions, please check the CPGA website on the Friday/Saturday beforehand. Individual e-mails will be sent to club secretaries of registered crews.

Car Parking for Newquay County Championships

Firstly, a quick reminder that **South Quay Hill will be closed to traffic** during the championships weekend. **Car Parking spaces will be reserved for towing vehicles and trailers *where available*, and officials. Please be aware that the car parking charges are still in operation despite the road closure.** There will be space to load/unload gigs and equipment but we ask that rowers use one of the town car parks (listed below). Please do not double park or park on the quay itself as this is permit holder only for commercial fishermen who require access to the quay and also to the fishing containers in the car park at all times, and the lifeboat launch area must also remain clear.

In order of distance – walking times taken from google maps and prices are as shown on the website:

Belmont Car Park - £6.80 per day (5 mins walk) This is the nearest car park to the harbour and it is down the road from the Tower Road (mini golf) car park on the left hand side, accessed via Toby Way.

Dane Road - £6.80 per day (6 mins)

Mount Wise - £6.80 per day (9 mins)

Atlantic Road - £6.80 per day (9 mins)

Towan Headland - £6.80 (12 mins)

Tregunnel Hill - £6.80 per day (15 mins max)



Tower Road also has a couple of other small car parks on private land which offer rates of around £5 per day.
